# Chichester Camera Club New and Aspiring Photographers

## Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd April 2023

It also was a very good chance to feel like a full member of the club, network and share ideas and tips. The cakes were **outstanding** too."

#### **Call for Entries**

The exhibition is open to all Print and Projected Digital Image (PDI) photographers of Chichester Camera Club who have Club or Intermediate status.

This year's exhibition will be held at Tangmere Village Centre and will be open to the public on Saturday 1st April, 10am - 5pm and on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 10am - 4pm.

#### **Prints**

Each exhibitor will have one 6ft by 4ft screen and then what you show is entirely up to you – whether that's one single postage stamp size image or a multitude of images to create a collage. You can use foam board, show prints with no mounts, create a classic panel or fill the space with one giant print .You are entirely free to exhibit work as you choose and will be responsible for your own display. There will be no judging!

### Three past layouts



- You will need to write a short introduction about you and/or your images. It can be an
  explanation of the work, what you enjoy about photography, or the inspiration behind
  your display. These will be produced on A5 cards in a 'house style' by the committee,
  so need to be emailed to Sarah Nichol by 24<sup>th</sup> March.
- In order to show a balanced exhibition, we will need an A4 sheet showing your hanging plan, in colour. This paper copy needs to be with Sarah Nichol by 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2023.

(An easy way is to put the images on the floor and take a photograph.)

 You will need to hang your own work on Saturday 1st April from 8am - 9.30am, ready for the opening at 10am (fixings will be provided), and you must take down your work on the Sunday after closing.

### **Projected Digital Images**

Projected digital images will be shown in a continuous loop on the large screen television in the small hall. You may enter up to 6 images and will need to enter these in the usual way through the club website, under Spring Exhibition, by **Thursday16th March 2022.** 

#### Other Details

There is a hanging fee of £12 to cover hire of the hall and expenses. There is no charge for PDIs. You may also display cards and other prints for sale at a central point. Your help will be needed to set up and dismantle the Hall and also throughout the weekend.

This is an ideal opportunity to talk about your work with fellow members of the club and the general public. Posters and flyers will be available to promote the event and your help in distributing these widely will be appreciated.

Refreshments will be available during the exhibition, as well as a raffle. It will be appreciated if all exhibitors could help by donating a cake (homemade would be great!) and a raffle prize.
