



## PAGB - The Photographic Alliance of Great Britain

- Co-ordinates specific activities for photographic clubs in England, Scotland, Wales & Northern Ireland (Federations)
- Organises national competitive photographic events for its Federations/clubs
- Recorded Lectures to clubs
- Photographic Distinctions (known as awards for photographic merit) direct to qualifying club members
- Strong links with similar organisations in different countries via its membership of FIAP
- Run by an Executive committee
  - Members nominated and elected from members of each Federation
  - Executive meets three times per year

# The Southern Counties Photographic Federation

#### Serves:

- Hampshire
- Part of West Sussex

- Approximately 70 clubs
- Run by a council of 15 volunteer officers from clubs
- Member of the PAGB
- Created 1963, formerly the Hants and South Wilts Photographic Federation
- Access to national and international exhibitions (through FIAP)
  Website listing services, judges & lecturers

### **BPE – British Photographic Exhibitions**

A circuit of exhibitions open to all photographers in England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland

Run separately from any other organisation and does not have a membership

Linked to the PAGB in that BPE exhibitions have PAGB patronage and medals

The BPE awards life-time honours for acceptances in BPE exhibitions



### FIAP - La Federation Internationale de l'Art Photographique

- International Federation
- Members are national photographic Federations, one per country
- Formed in 1950 with the concept of a worldwide international body devoted to promoting and encouraging photographic art in all its aspects
- Currently some 86 countries are Operational Members (National Federations) of FIAP
- Represents well over a million photographers
- FIAP has no employees All voluntary
